it means
the world warlock
the world is locked into war
and cannot escape it because
it cannot think of anything else
Oh I do fear the catastrophe
end of this year you know

2012 yes I know

but you mustn't believe these things

but I do

the world will end be destroyed

not by asteroids nor aliens

but by narrow minds

I feel it I sense it

oh I wish he were here

now about these walls

what colours do you think

oh I think we should go for pale

light pastel colours don't you

yellow for the drawing rooms

blue for the kitchens

and blue and rose for the bedrooms

I knew I could rely on you

to be sensible and come up with

such a good solution

I'll arrange for the gangs

to start right away

Thinker is alert to changes going on around him

He is aware of moves being made by the gargoyles

Cruelty and Despair

Cruelty has found an ally for their plans

He is Tenor Mander

a young rebellious type who sees no representation of himself and his country at the World Conference

so Cruelty enters his mind and encourages Tenor to take action

killing members of the Conference
